External Email Communication

To all members of City Council;

I want to express my concern about the new parking regulations that take place beginning next week around the Elm Street Clinic. The clinic has a very small inadequate parking lot that can not accommodate the staff. The staff has relied on parking on Odeon and Wade next to the clinic, and also on Central Parkway behind the clinic. Beginning next week Odeon and Wade become residential parking only, and parking on Central Parkway will be metered parking only. This leaves staff with either walking a couple of blocks (this time of year in the dark) or paying out upwards of \$50 a week to park. I occasionally work at the clinic and I don't feel safe walking 2 blocks in the Over the Rhine, and would find it difficult to go outside to feed the meter every couple of hours or so. The clinic staff and the patients that they serve were not taken into consideration at all with these latest parking plans. These new parking arrangements need to be looked at again.
