On August 2, 2021, the Budget and Finance Committee referred the following item for a report.

COMMUNICATION, submitted by Councilmember Mann, from Melancthon W. Chatfield, regarding a property at 3500 Glenway Avenue, owned by The Hyde Park Lumber Company, requesting the City of Cincinnati forgive any and all current or back taxes.

In accordance with state and local law, any owner of property in Hamilton County may contest the property taxes owed on a subject property by challenging the underlying property value from which the property taxes are computed. In order to accomplish this, a property owner must file a complaint with the Hamilton County Board of Revisions.
