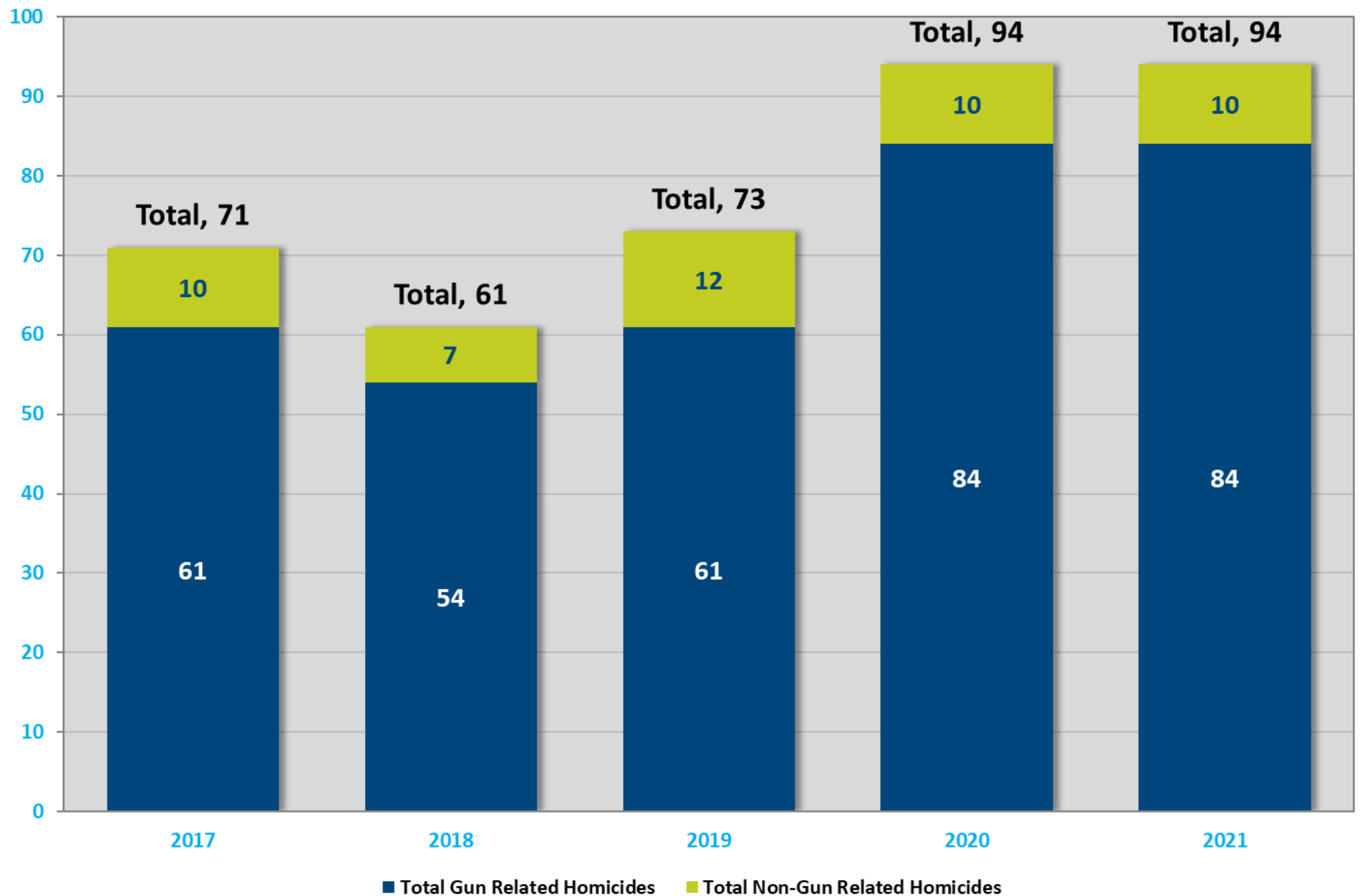

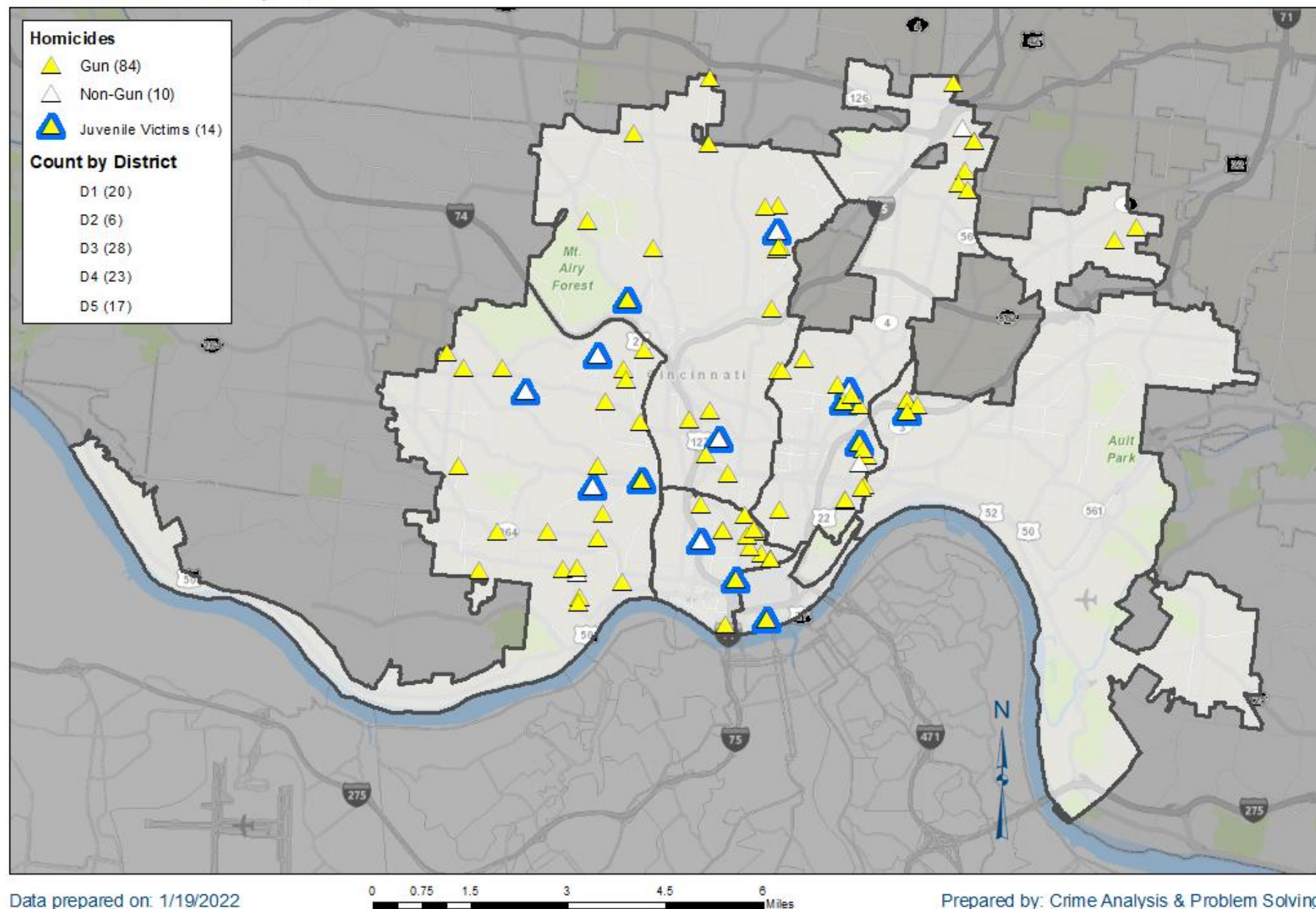

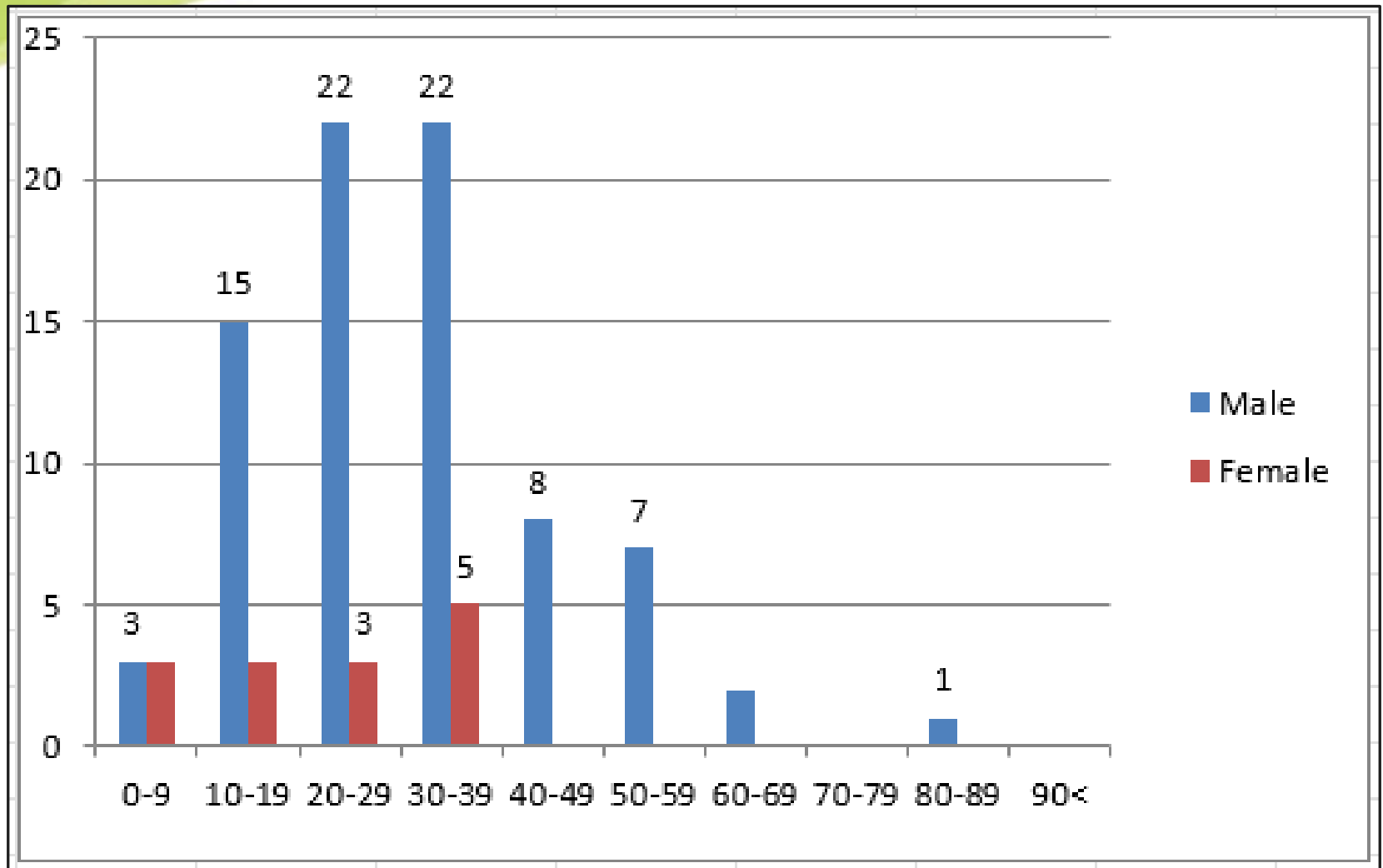

Case Closure Rate

- 2021 Closure Rate is 65% (2020 – 69%)
- A positive closure is considered:
 - Arrest
 - Death of Offender
 - Prosecution Declined
 - Suspect awaiting Grand Jury Presentation

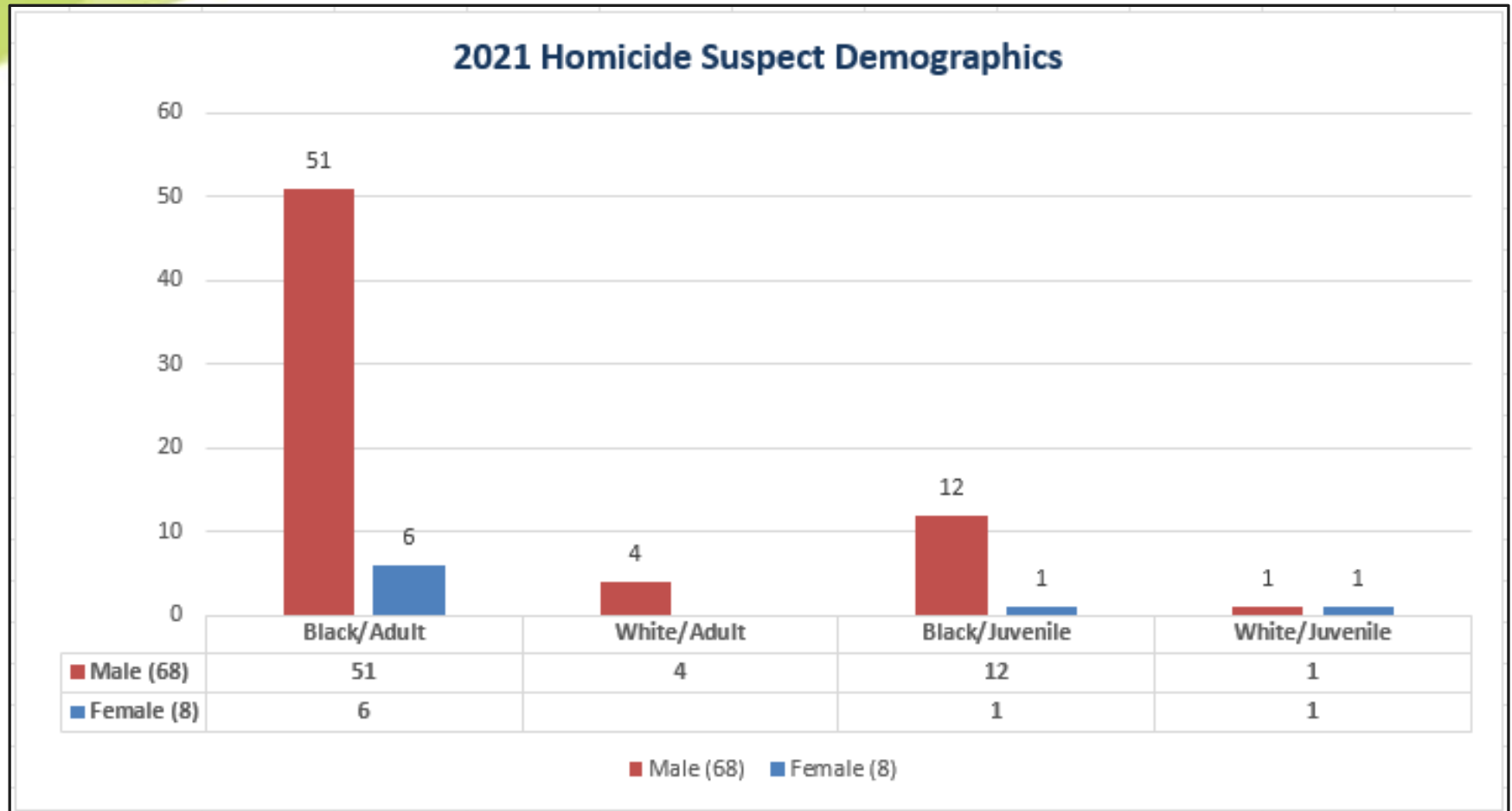

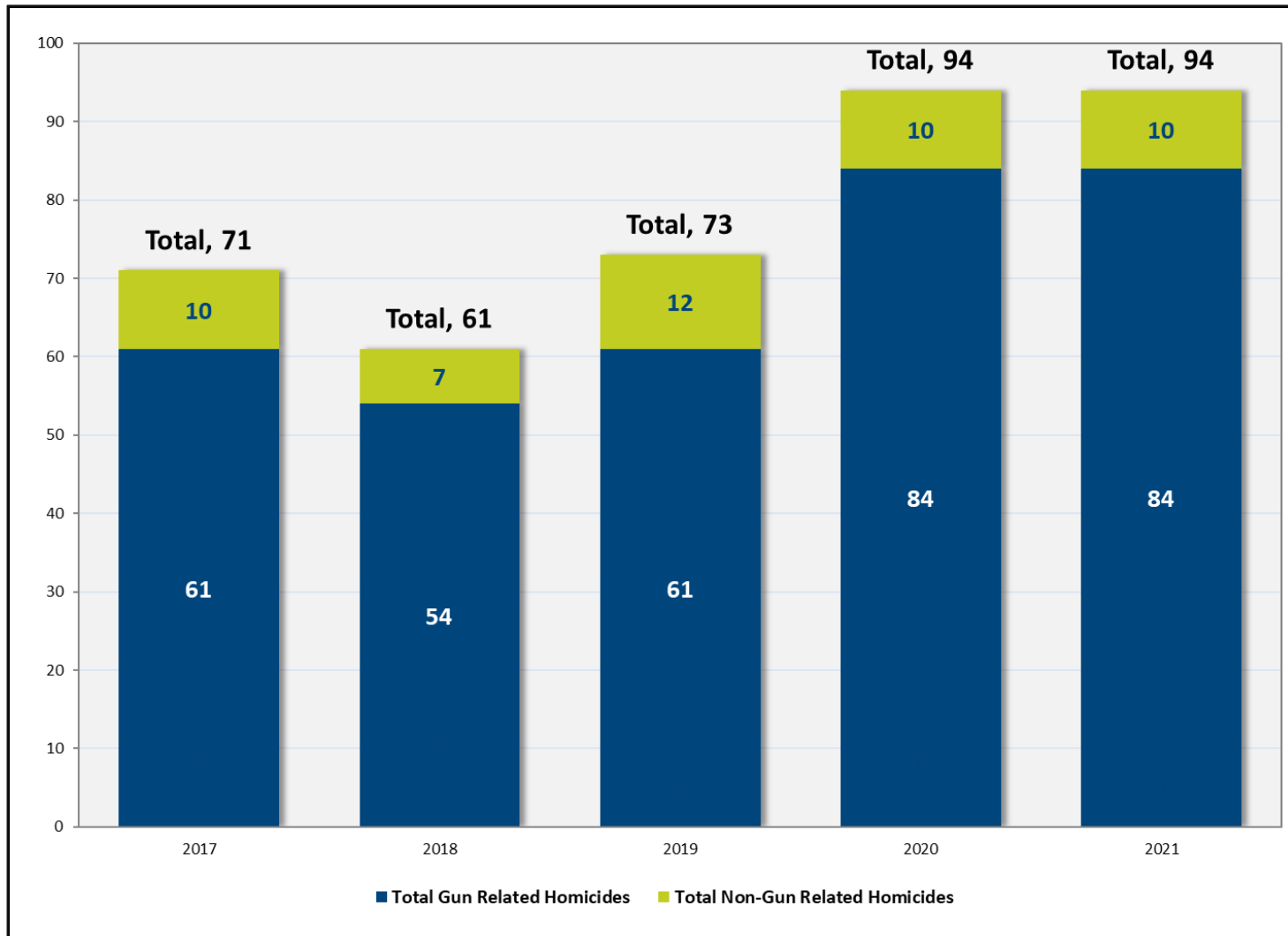

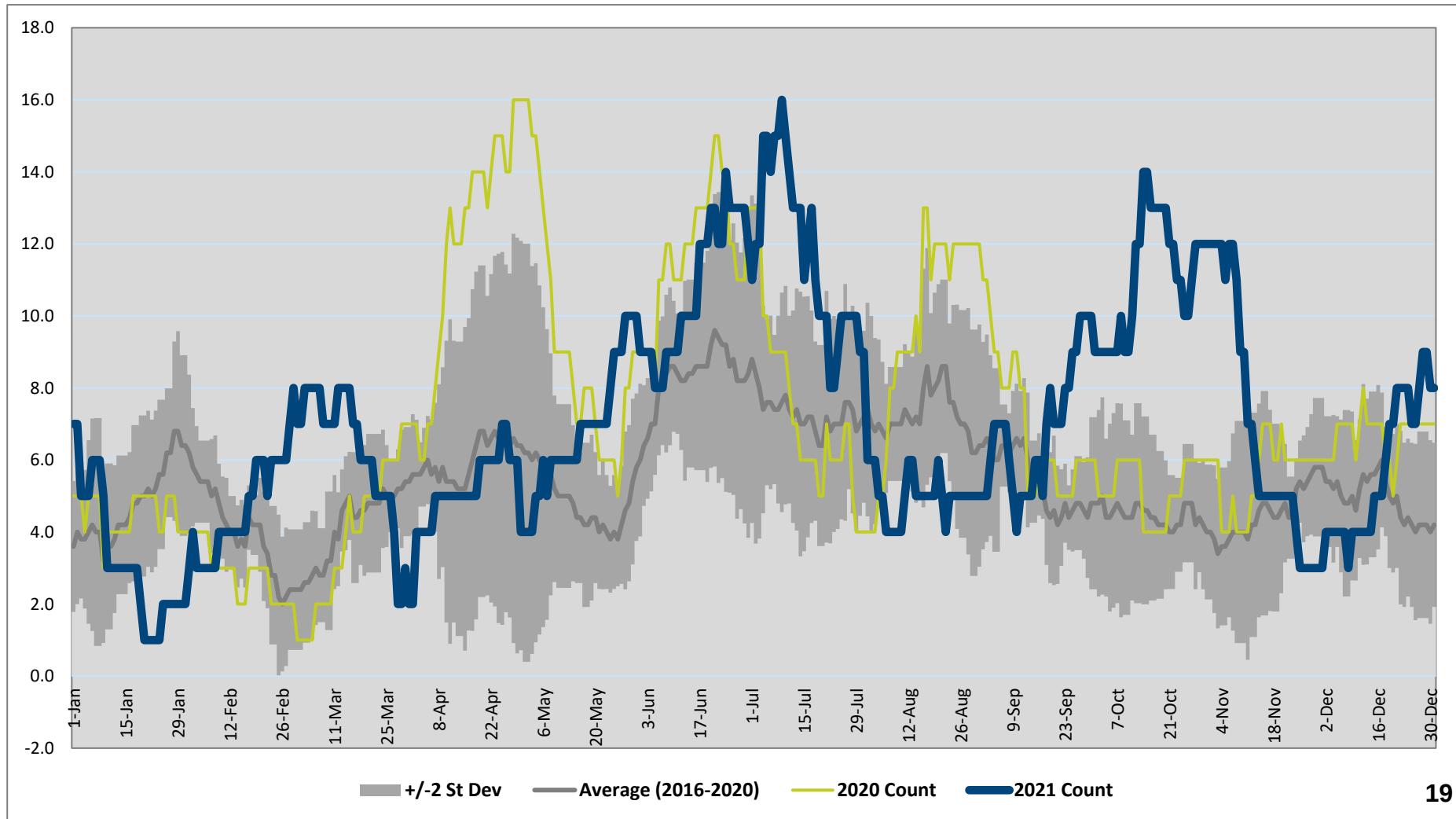

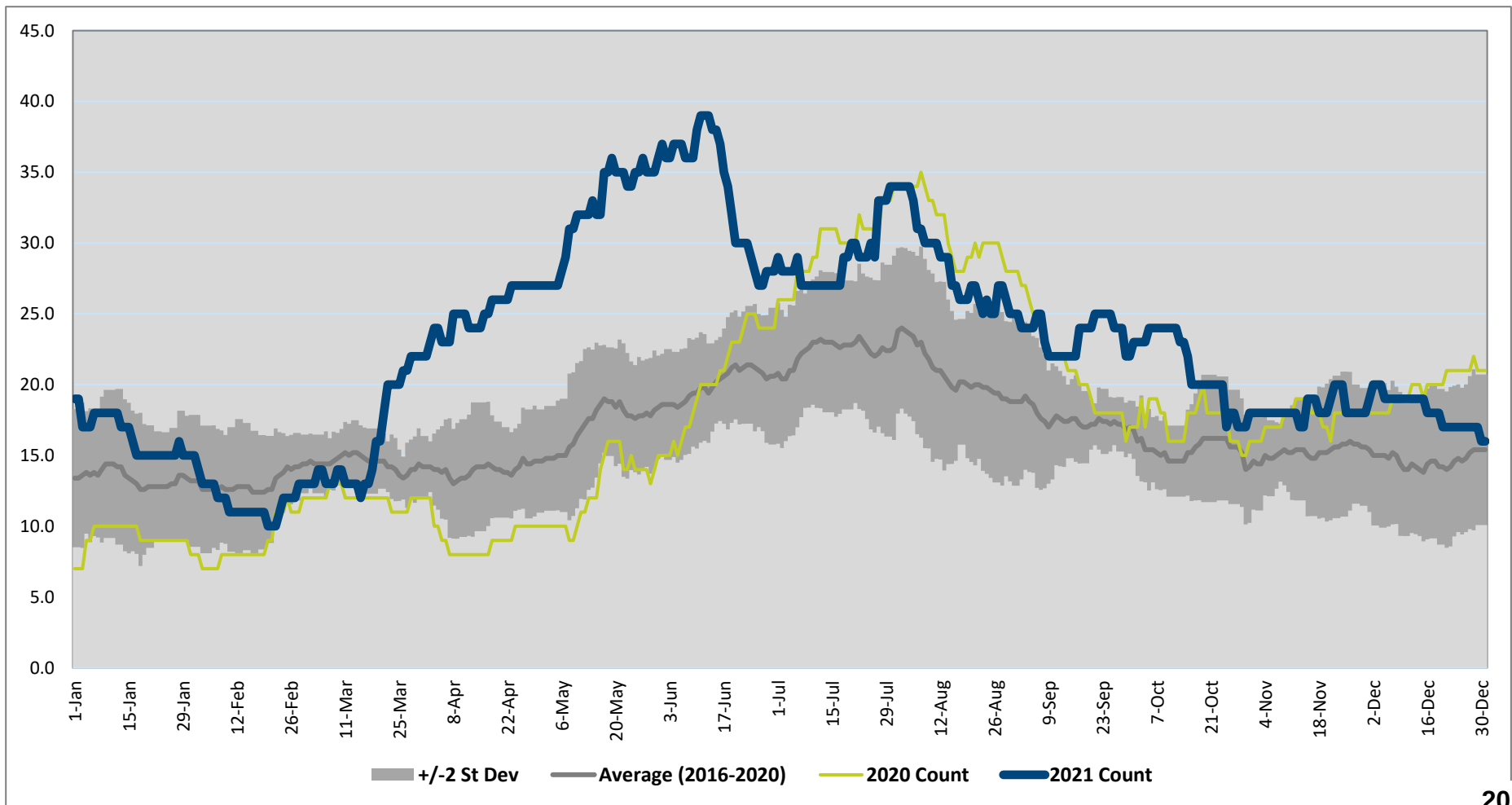
Gun and Non-Gun Homicide Victims: 2016-2021



Rolling 28 Day Homicides

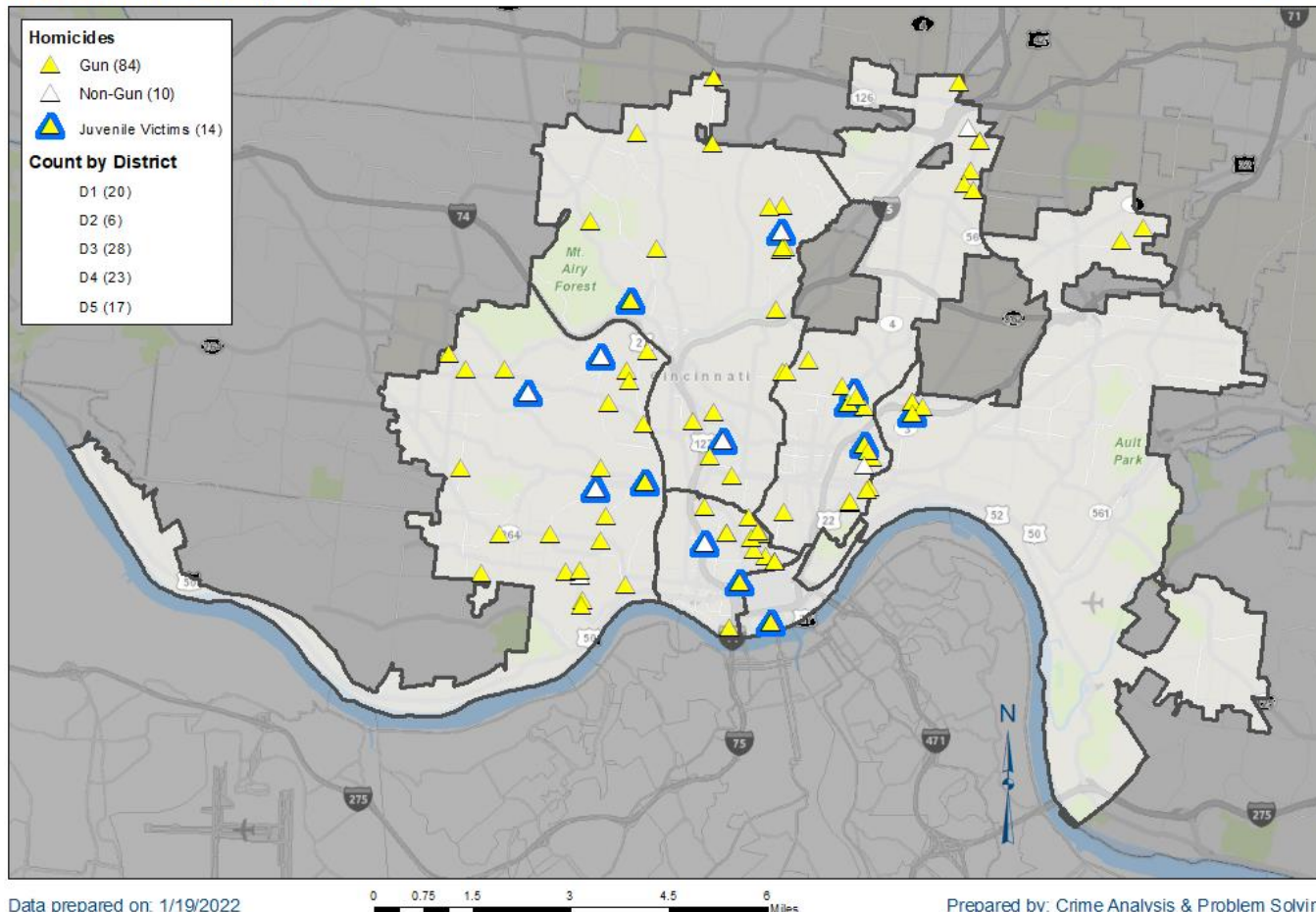

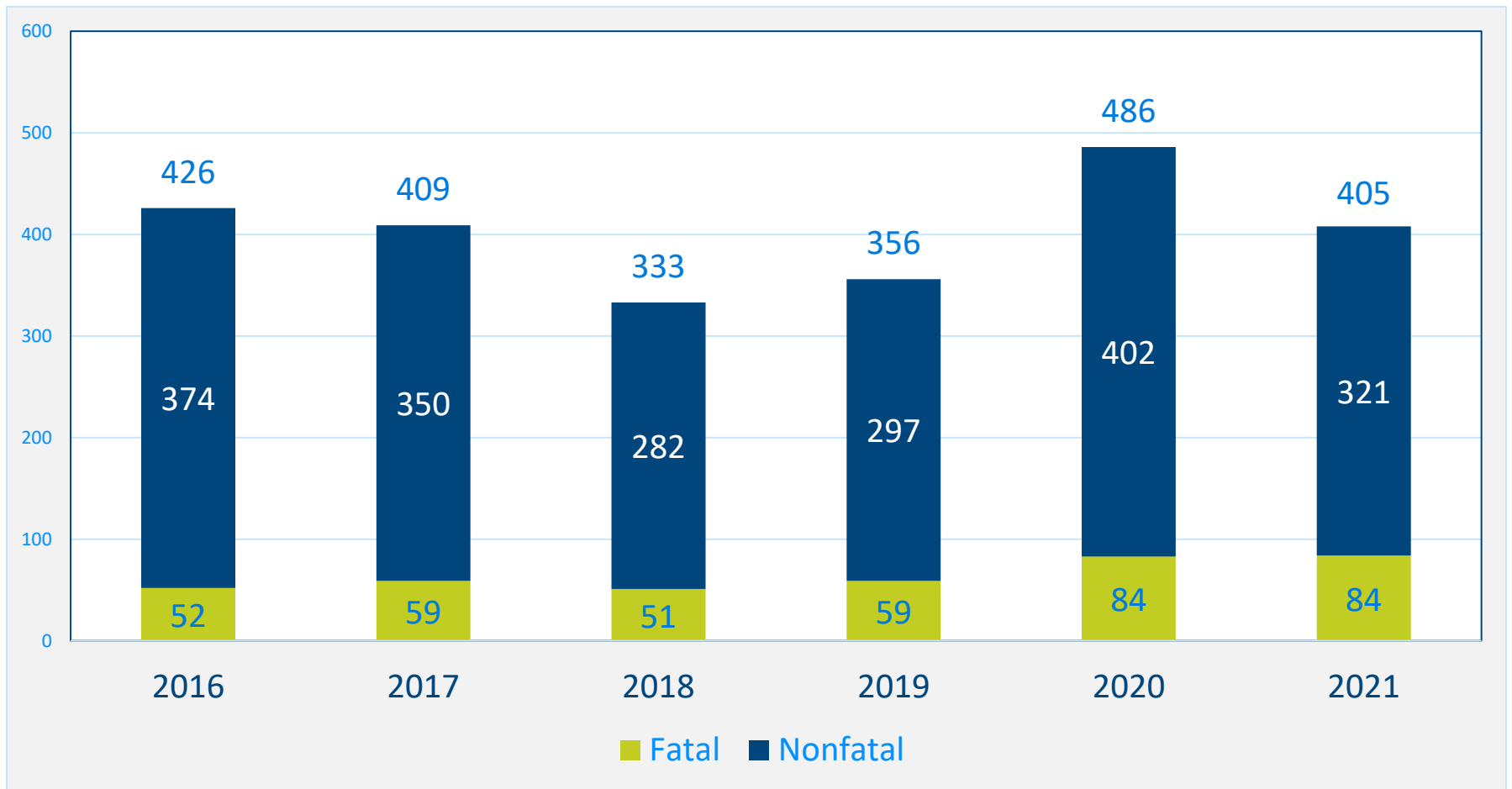

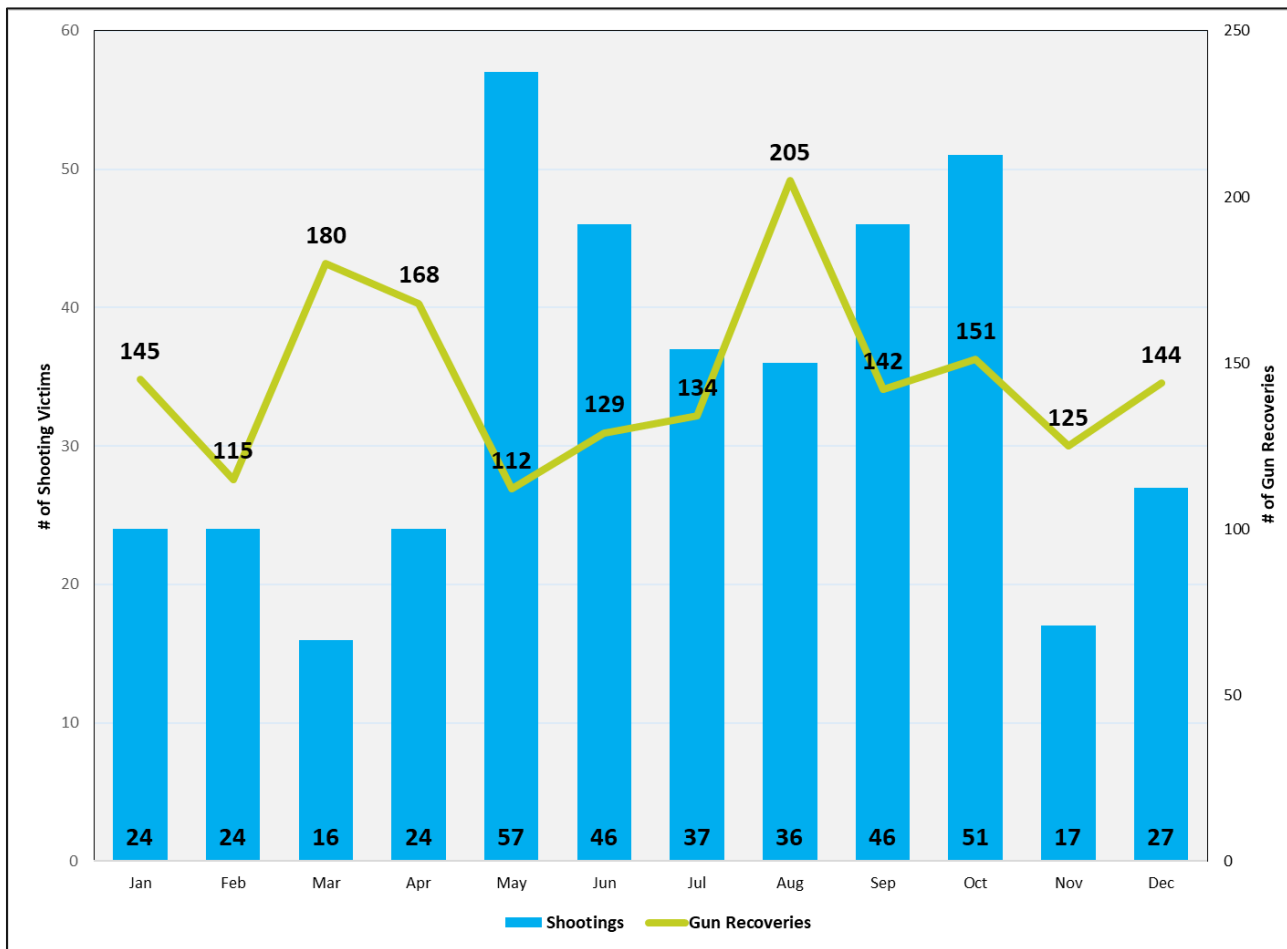
Homicide Victims across Cincinnati: Year End Total, 2021



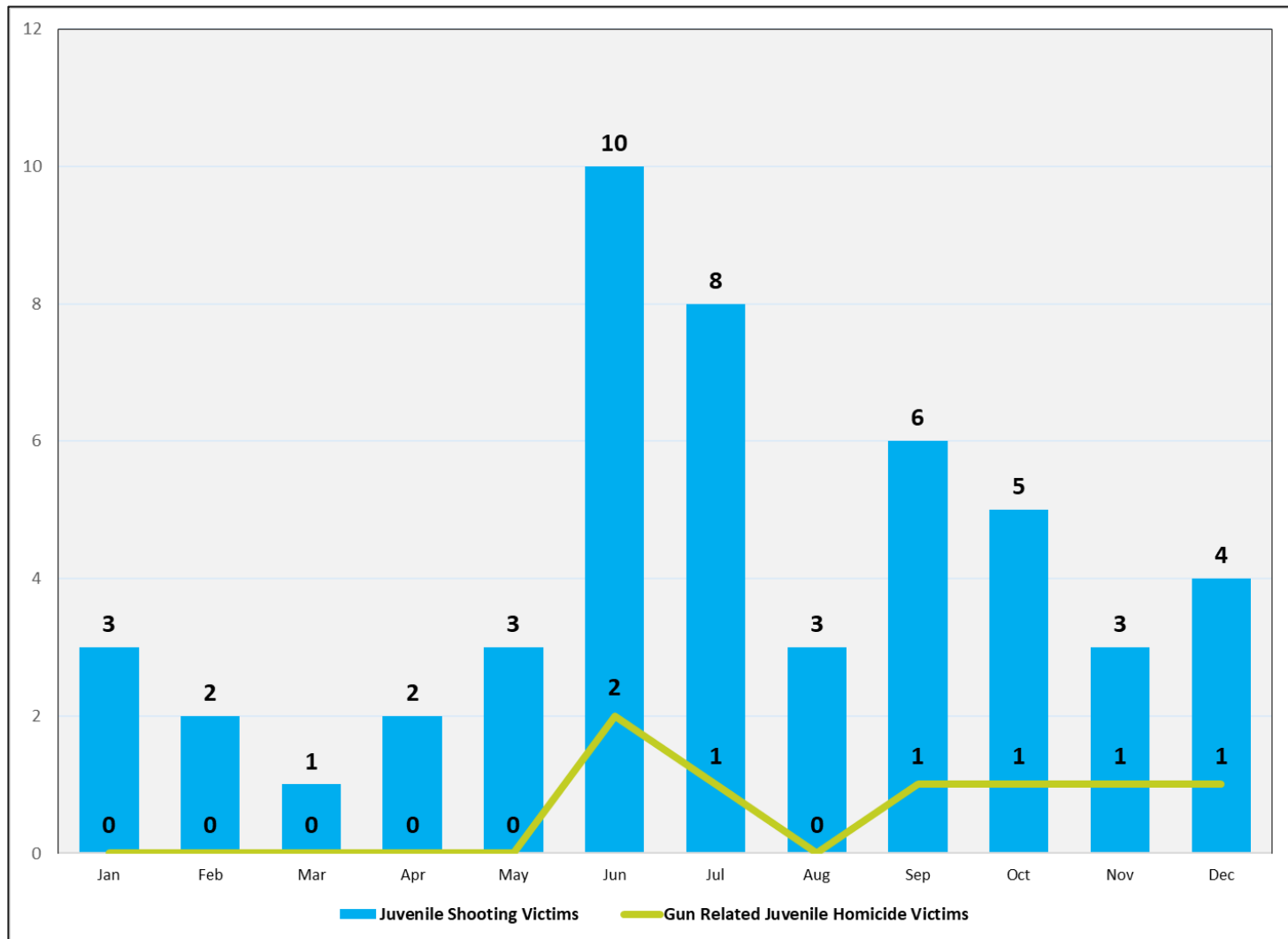
Shooting Victims: Non-Fatal vs Fatal



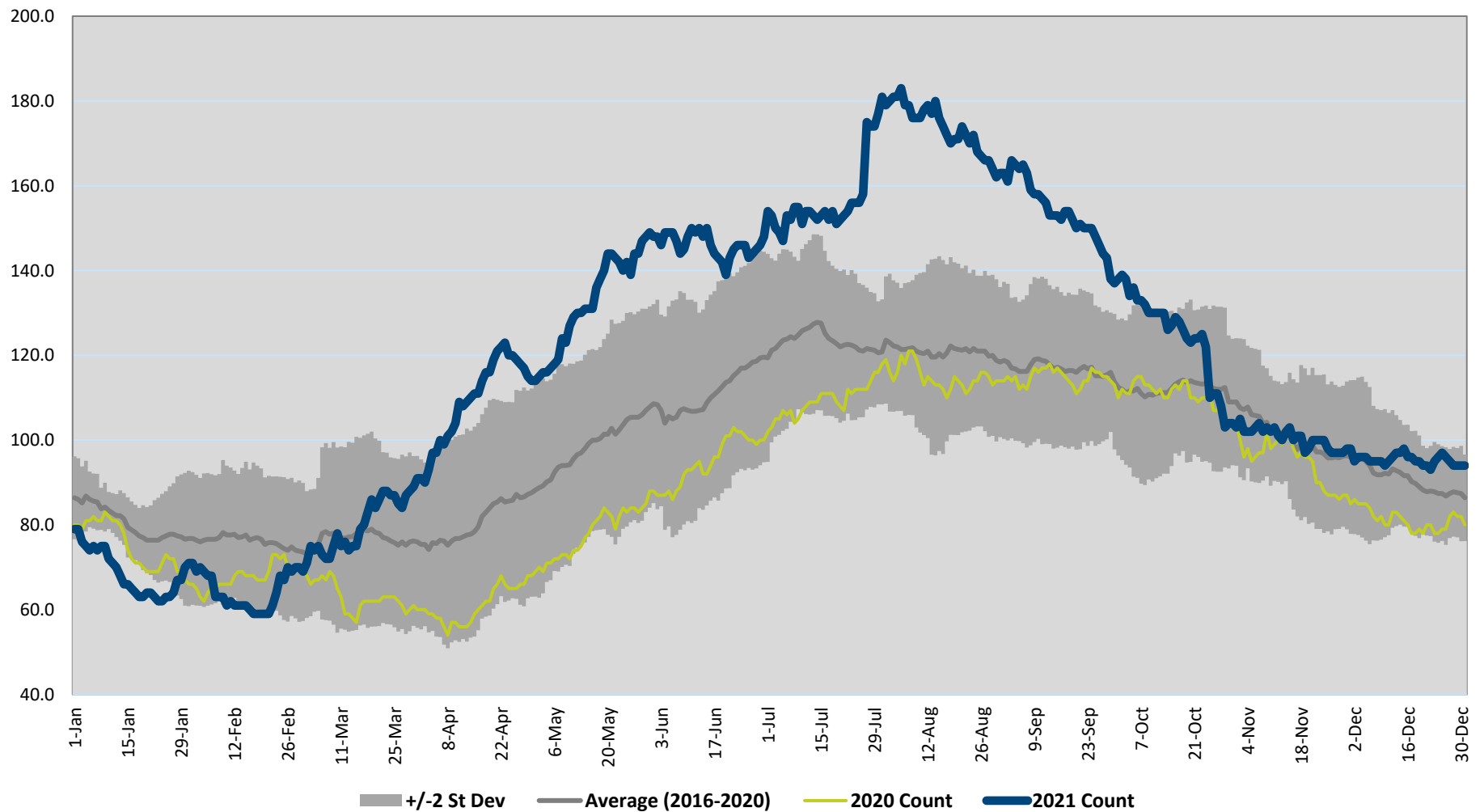
Shootings vs. Gun Recoveries: Count by Month



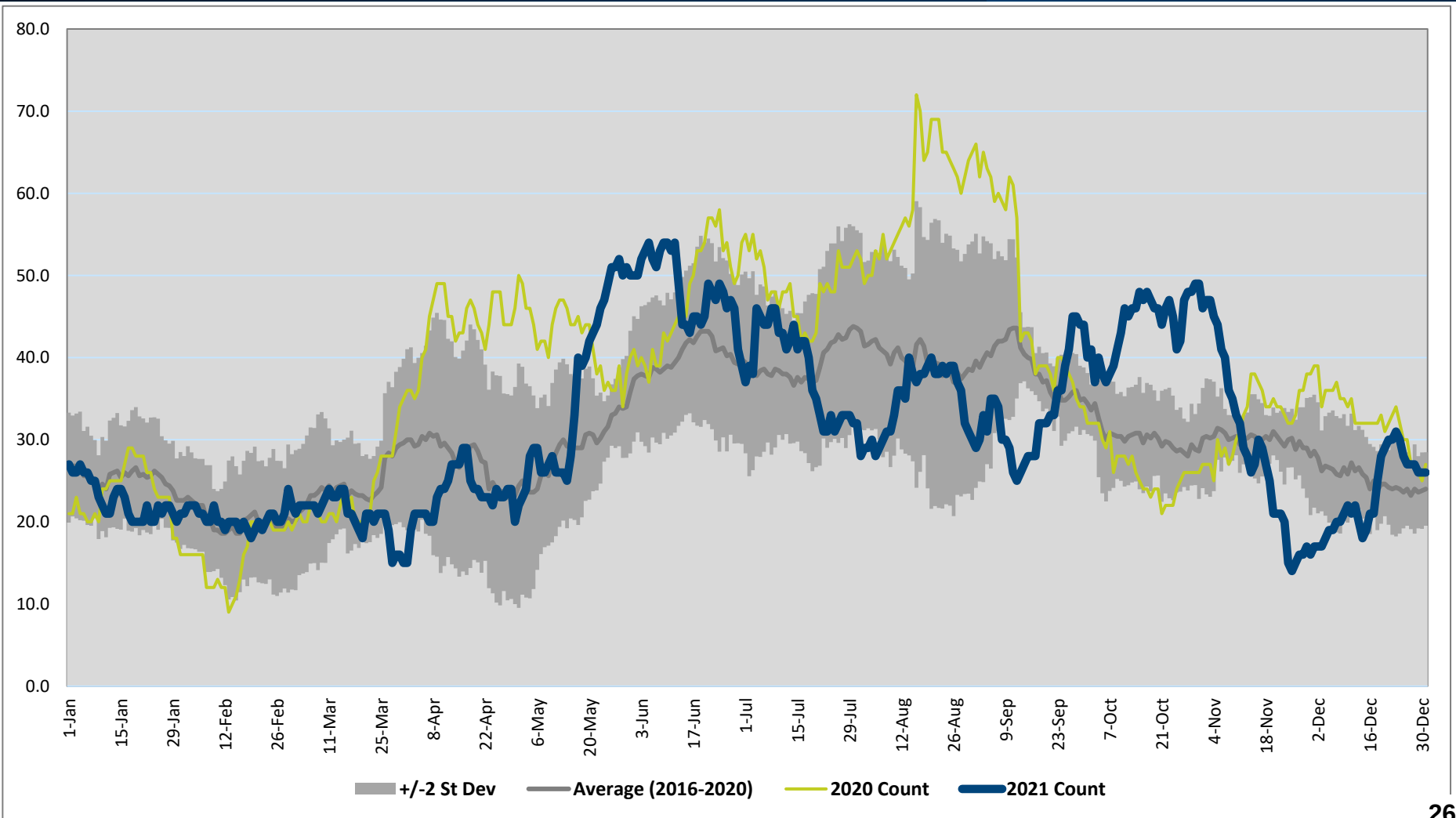

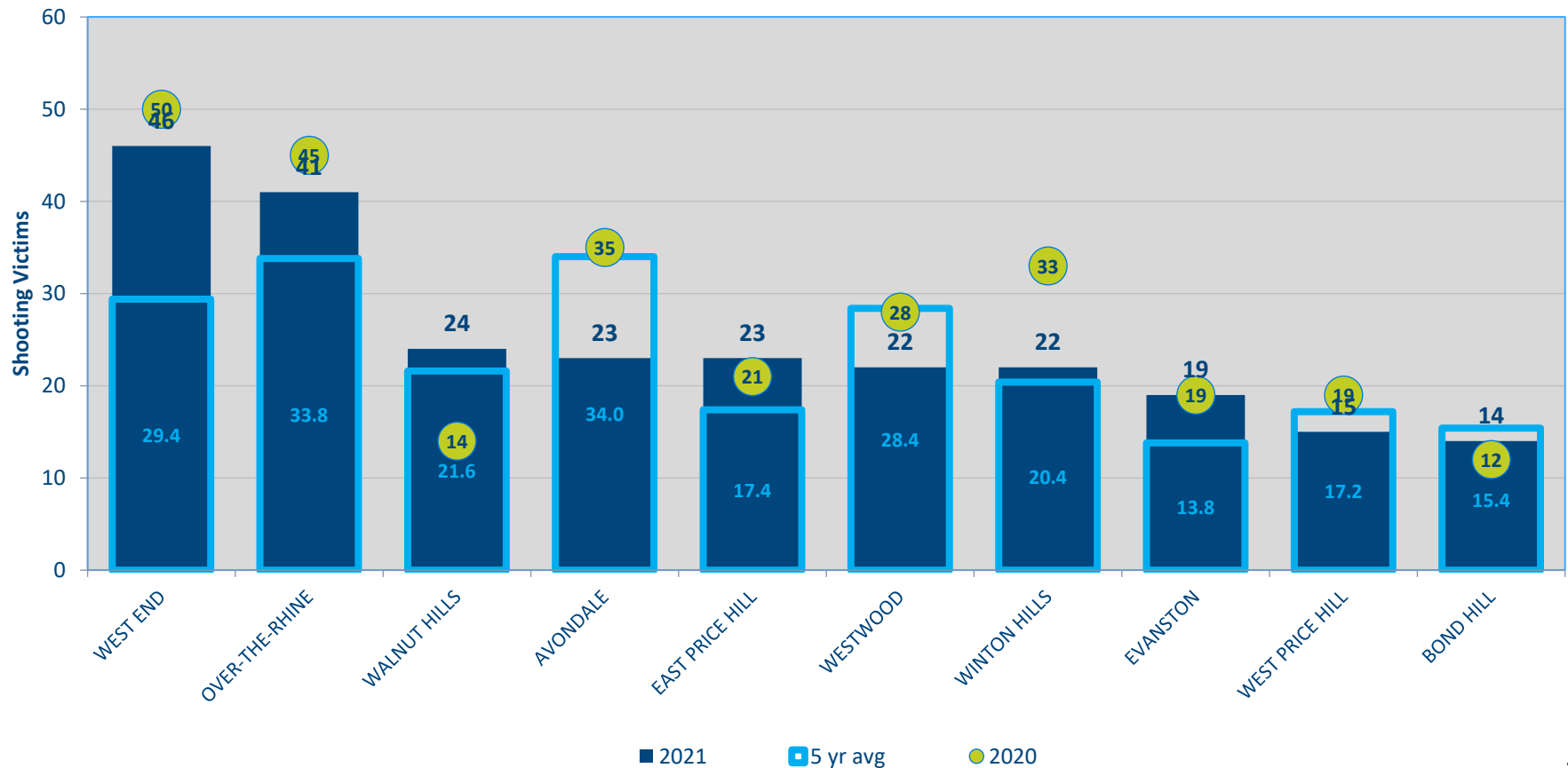
Rolling 90 Day Shooting Victim Count

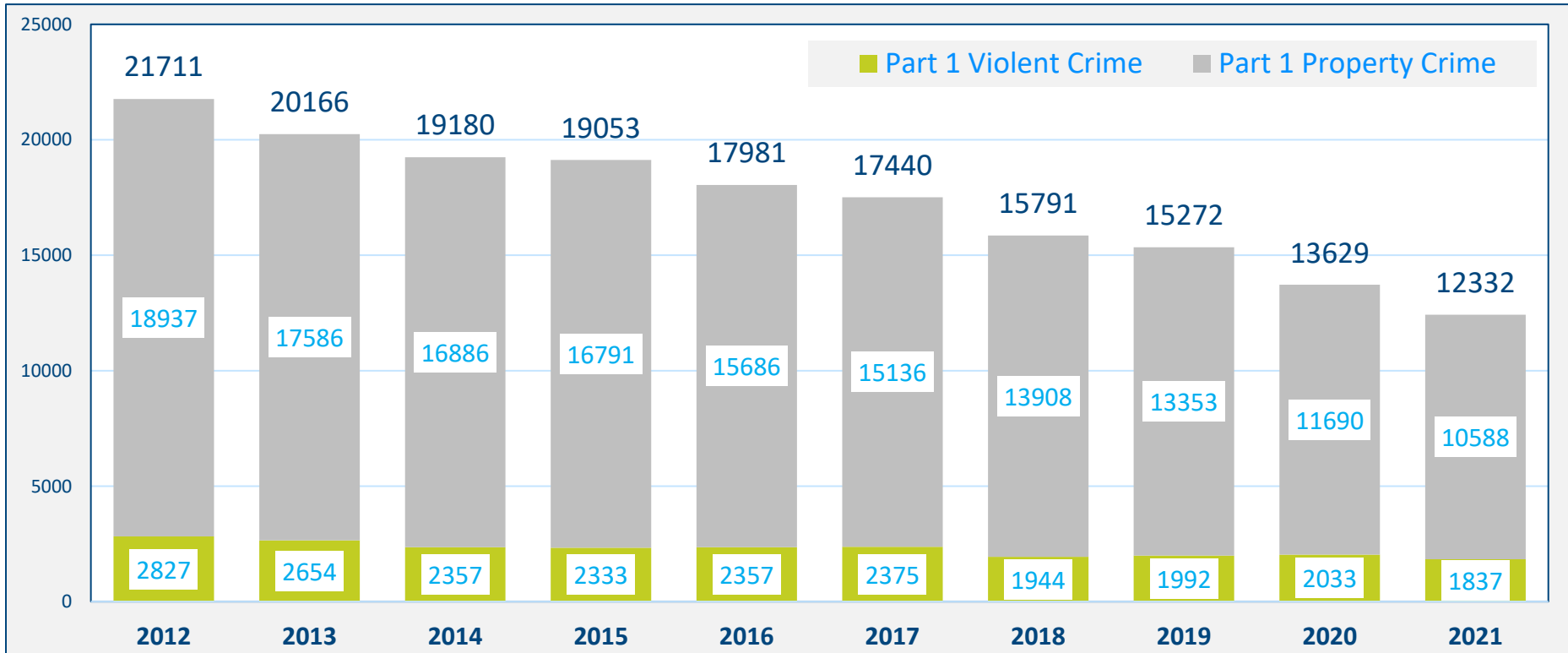

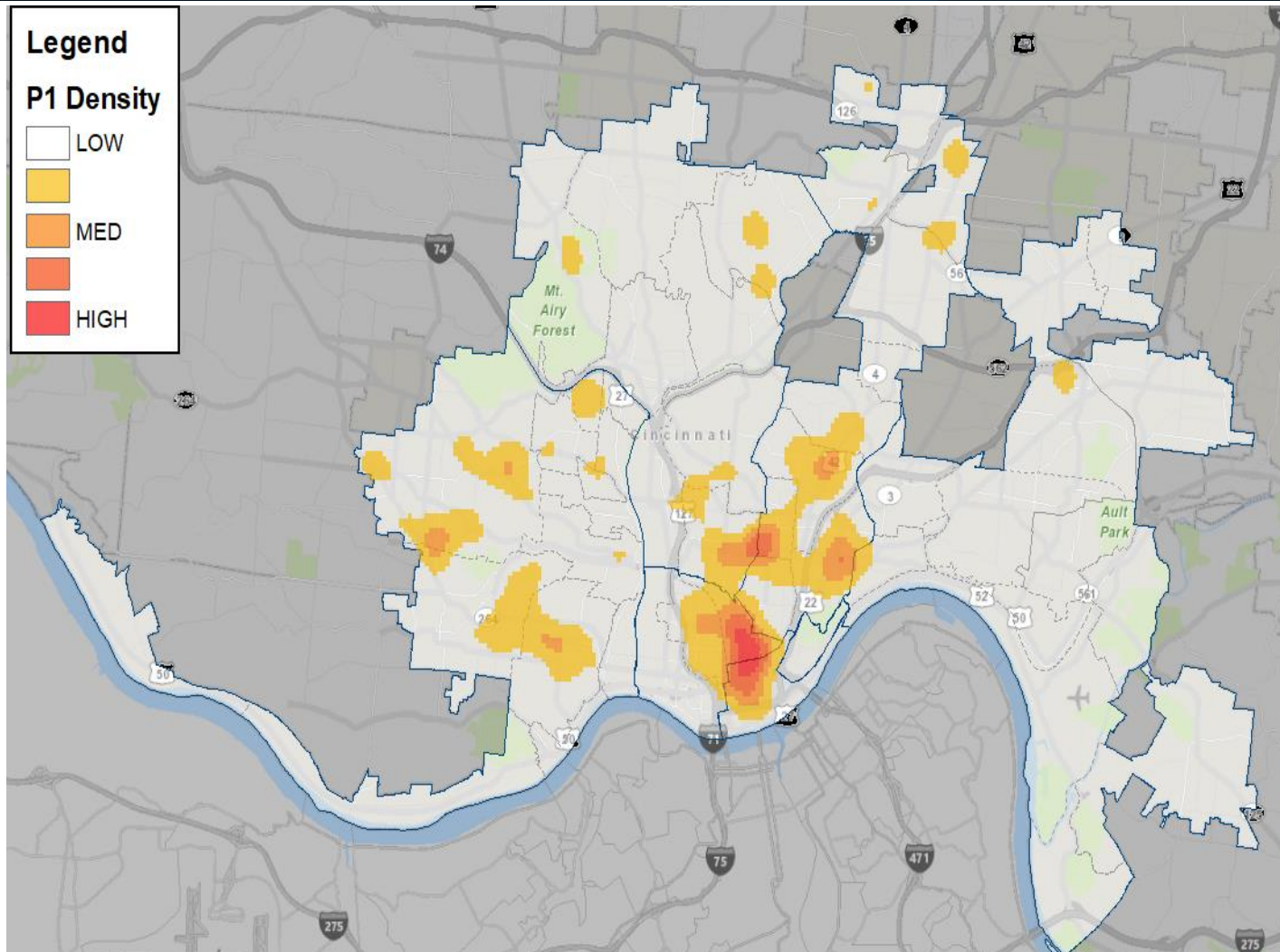

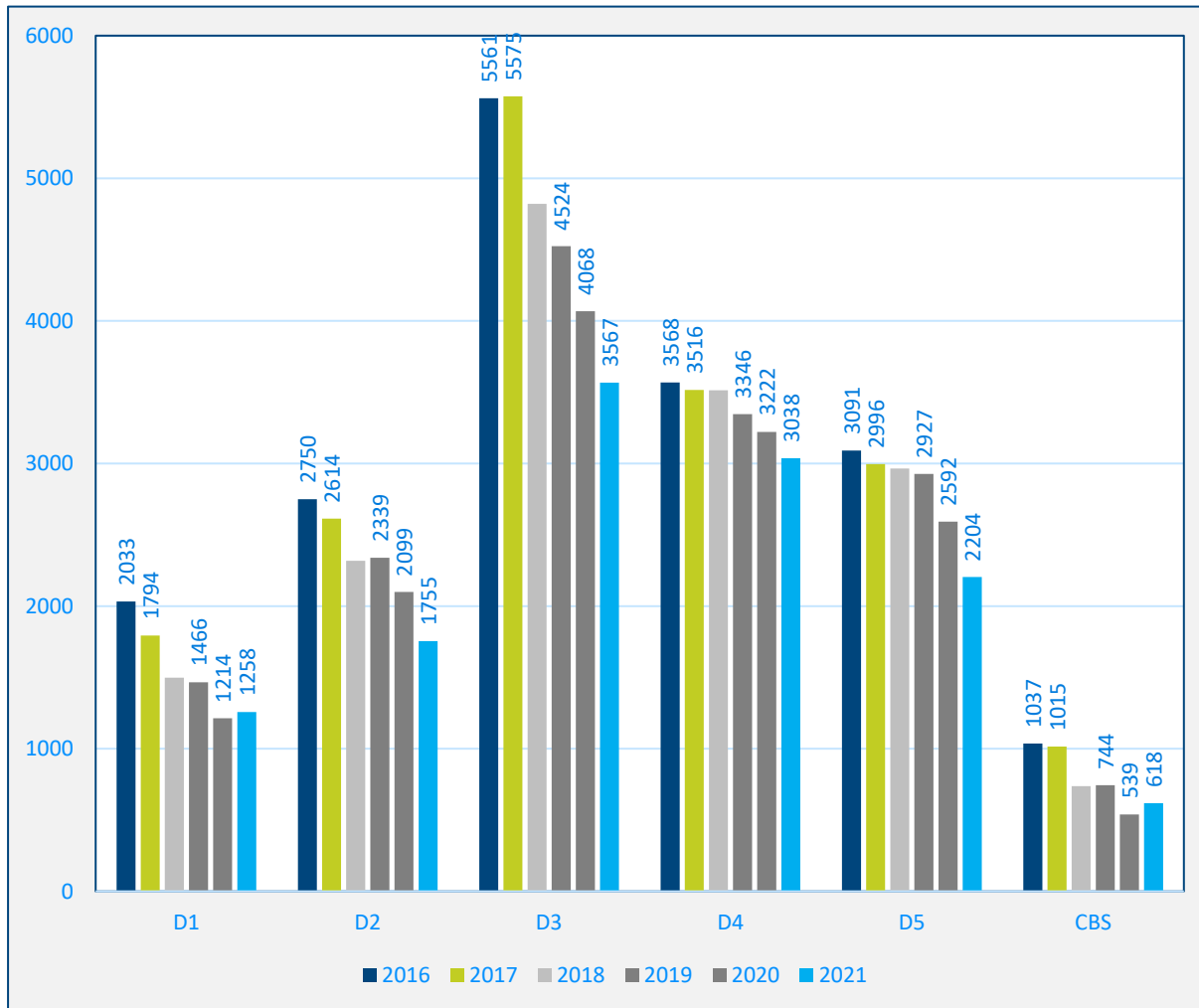

Total Part 1 Crime by District



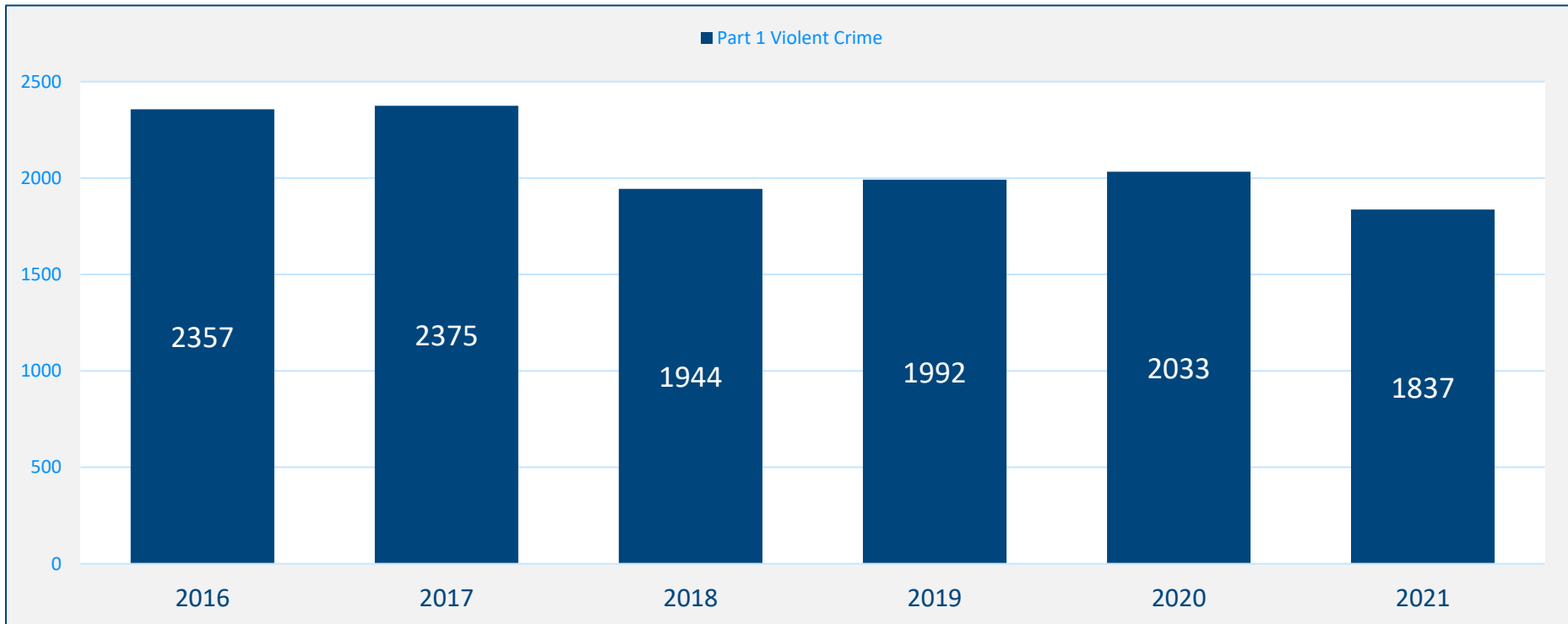

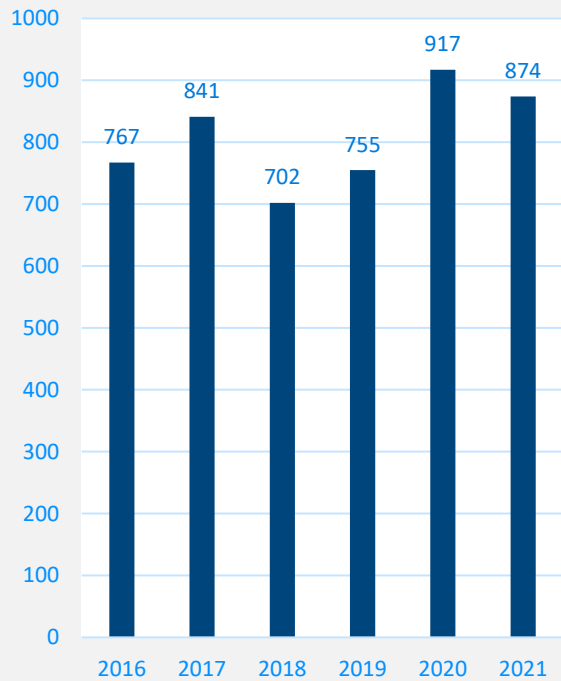

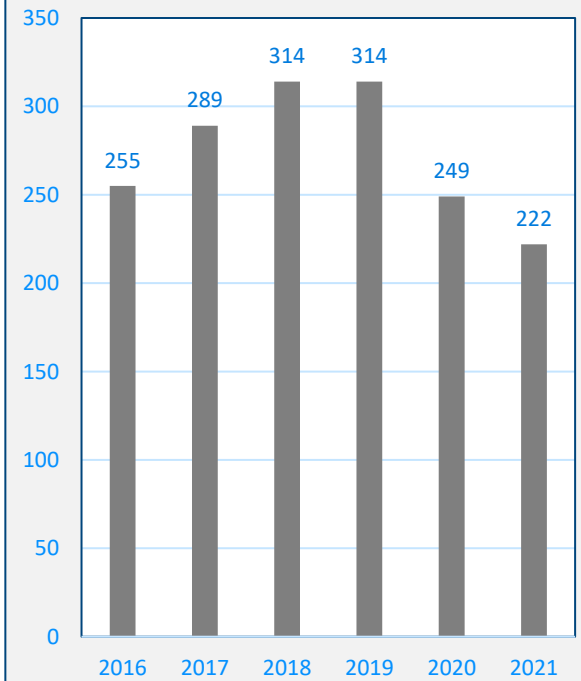

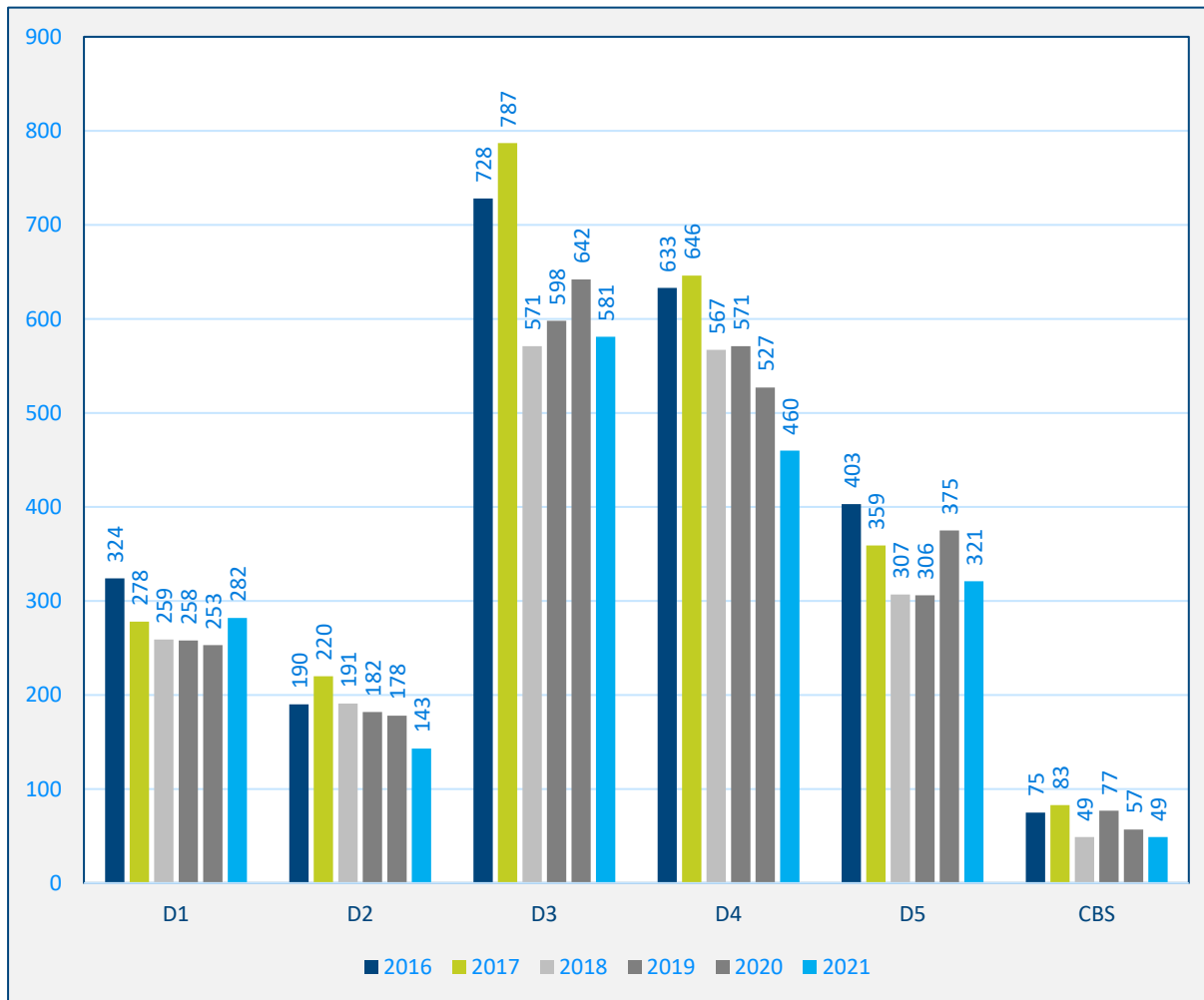

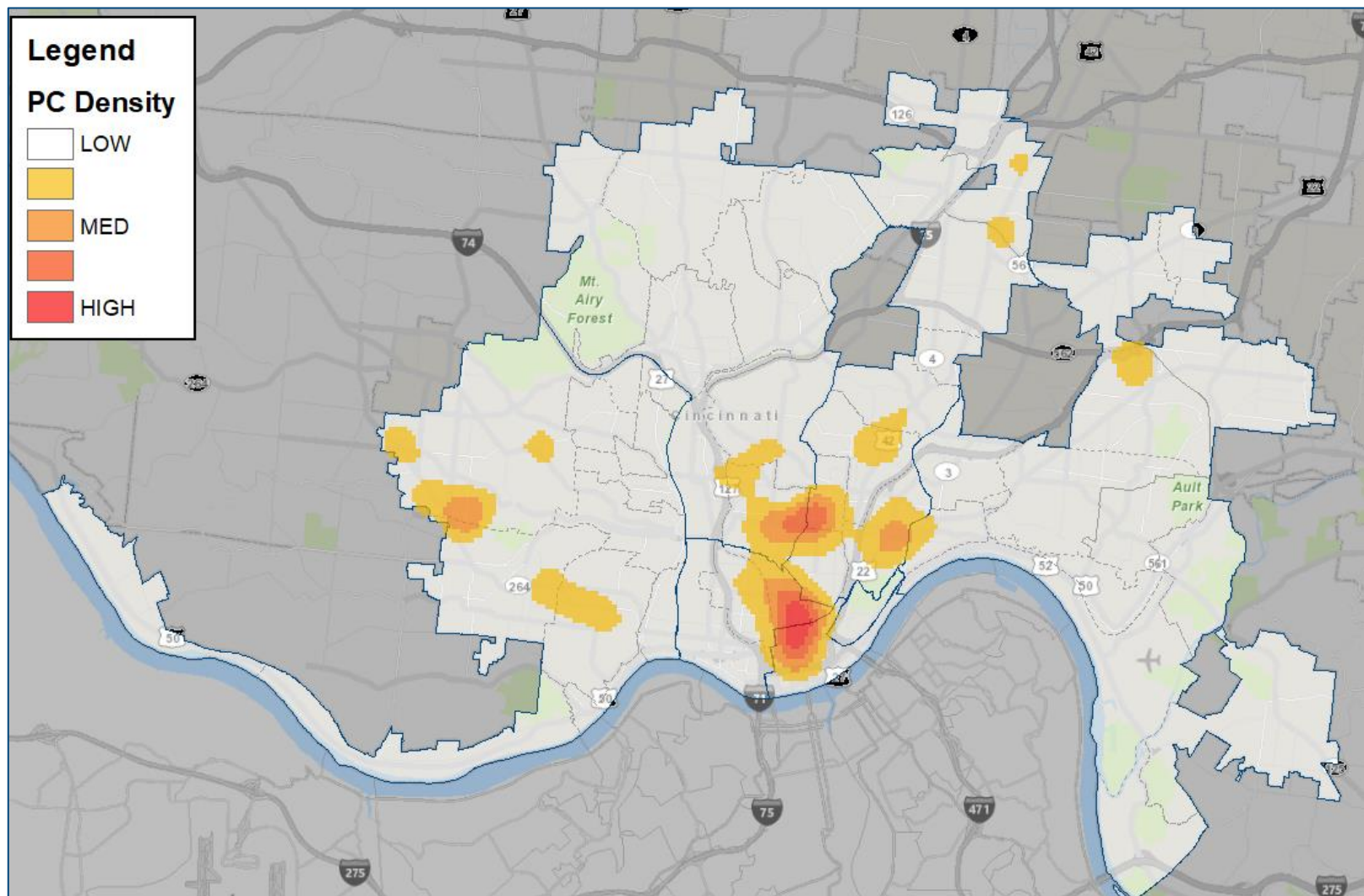

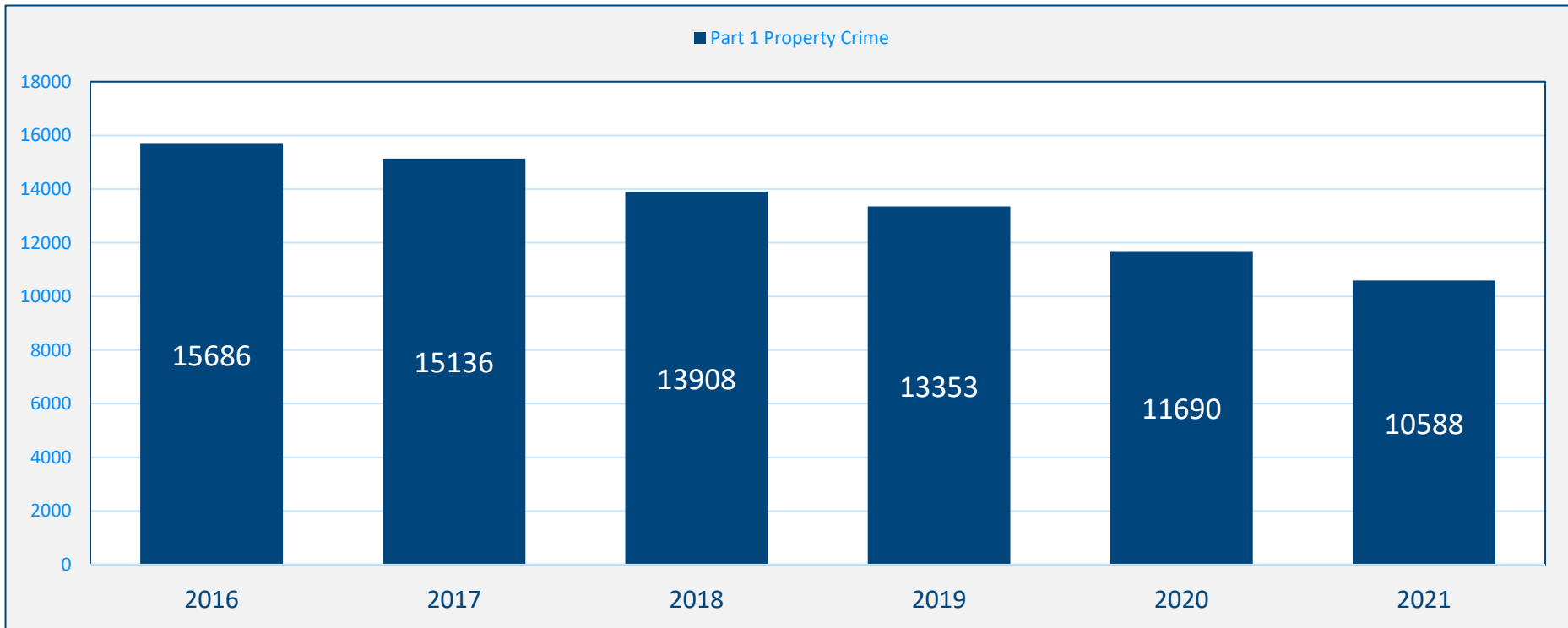

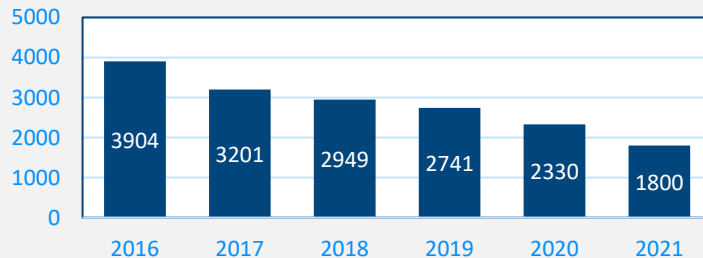

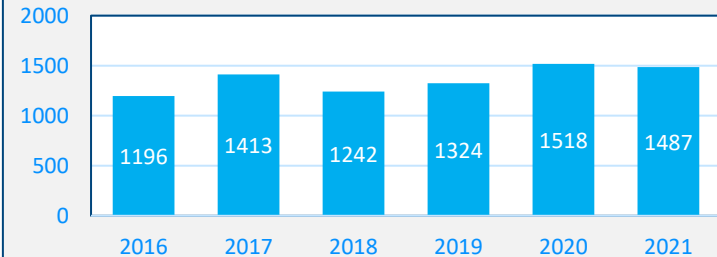

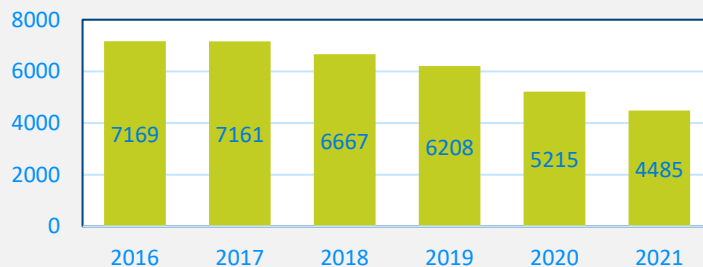

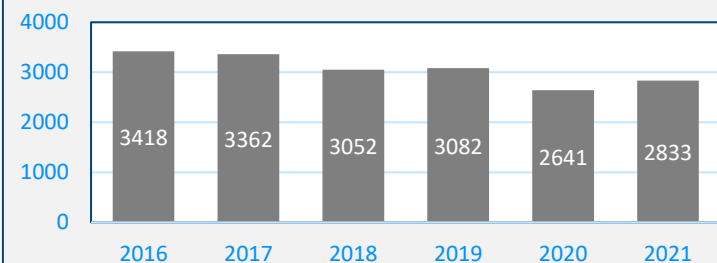

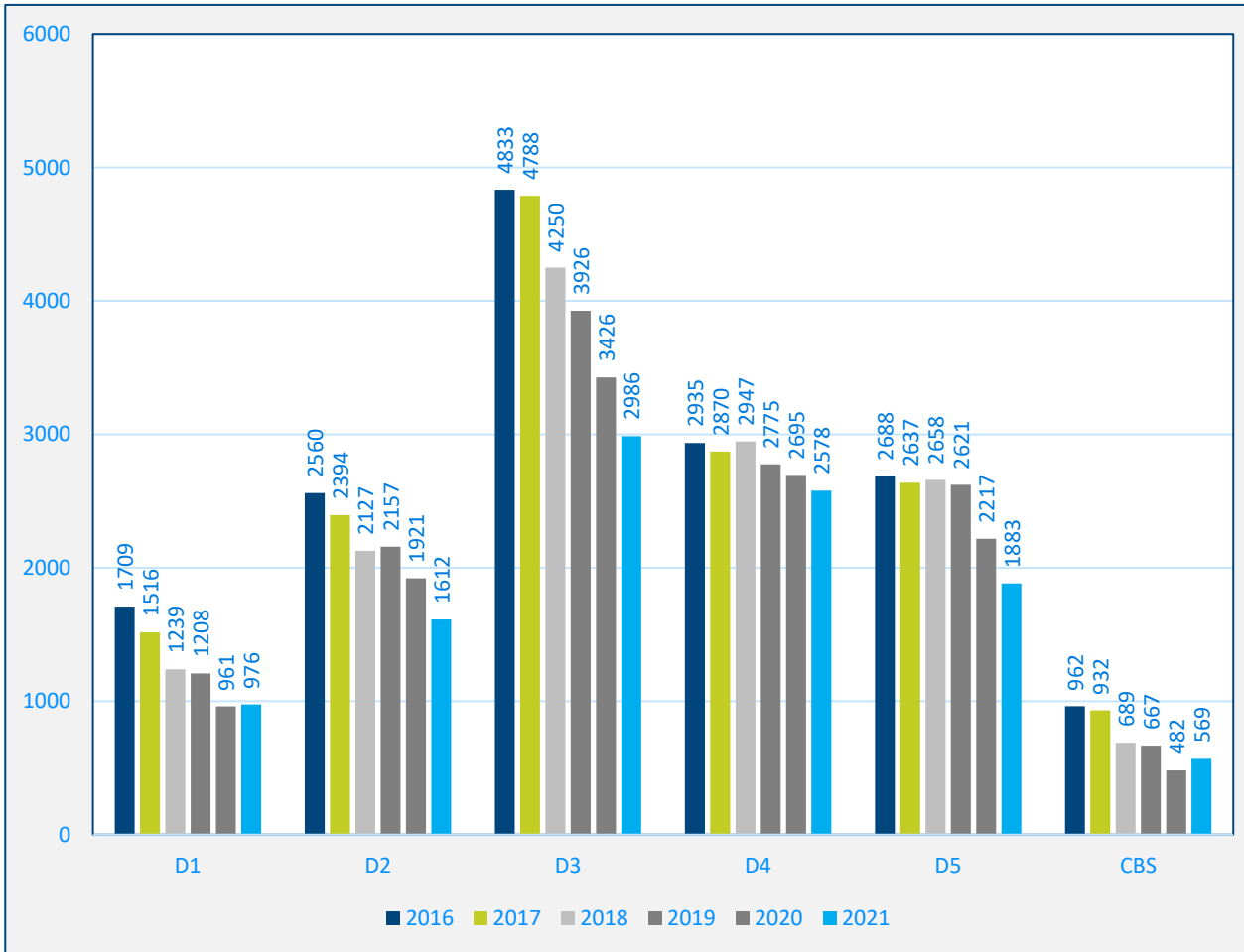
