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**ORDINANCE (EMERGENCY)** submitted by John P. Curp, Interim City Manager, on 6/15/2022, **MODIFYING** the provisions of Title V, "Traffic Code," of the Cincinnati Municipal Code by **ORDAINING** new Section 501-1-P11, "Person in Control;" **AMENDING** Section 511-31, "Storage of Unlicensed or Inoperable Vehicles in Residence or Commercial Districts," to provide that both the owner of a vehicle and the person in control of the property where an unlicensed or inoperable vehicle is illegally stored are liable for violations; **AMENDING** Section 512-26, "Penalty for Violation of Section 511-31; Impoundment," to clarify the available penalties; and **MODIFYING** Title XV, "Code Compliance and Hearings," of the Cincinnati Municipal Code by **AMENDING** Section 1501-5, "Class B Civil Offenses," to remove the violation of Section 511-31 as a Class B Civil Offense; and **AMENDING** Section 1501-8, "Class C1 Civil Offenses," to include the violation of Section 511-31 as a Class C1 Civil Offense.
