Title: ORDINANCE (EMERGENCY) submitted by Paula Boggs Muething, City Manager, on 11/9/2020, AUTHORIZING the transfer and appropriation of the sum of \$93,750 from the unappropriated surplus of Fund 151, "Bond Retirement," to Bond Retirement debt service account no. 151x134x7700 for the purpose of providing resources for the payment of debt service related to the installation of the historic Union Terminal murals at the Duke Energy Convention Center pursuant to an agreement between the City of Cincinnati and Hamilton County, by which the City and Hamilton County each agreed to bear one-half of the costs of the historic mural preservation and installation project, as provided in the Seventh and Eighth Supplements to the Cooperative Agreement between the City, the County, and the Convention Facilities Authority regarding the Duke Energy Convention Center.
