Title: ORDINANCE (EMERGENCY) submitted by Paula Boggs Muething, City Manager, on 5/3/2021, AUTHORIZING the City Manager to accept an American Rescue Plan Funding for Health Centers (“H8F”) grant in the amount up to \$9,975,375 from the United States Department of the Treasury as part of the American Rescue Plan Act for the purpose of supporting health centers funded under the Health Center Program to prevent, mitigate, and respond to the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (“COVID-19”) and to enhance health care services and infrastructure; AUTHORIZING the Finance Director to deposit the funds in Fund 469, “Local Fiscal Recovery,” revenue account no. 469x8543; AUTHORIZING the establishment of H8F grant project account no. 469x101xARP100, “Funding for Health Centers,” for the purpose of supporting health centers funded under the Health Center Program to prevent, mitigate, and respond to COVID-19 and to enhance health care services and infrastructure; AUTHORIZING the appropriation of the sum of \$9,975,375 from the unappropriated surplus of Local Fiscal Recovery Fund 469 to newly established H8F grant project account no. 469x101xARP100, “Funding for Health Centers,” for the purpose of providing support for the Cincinnati Health Department in providing equitable access to COVID-19 vaccinations, testing, and treatment as well as other current and anticipated COVID-19 and primary health care needs within the most vulnerable communities; and further DECLARING expenditures from American Rescue Plan grant project account no. 469x101xARP100, “Funding for Health Centers,” to be for a public purpose.
