Title: ORDINANCE (EMERGENCY) submitted by Sheryl M. M. Long, City Manager, on 11/30/2022,

ESTABLISHING new capital improvement program project account nos. 980x232x232351, "Central & 8th Traffic Calming - Grant," for the purpose of providing Ohio Department of Transportation ("ODOT") grant resources for right of way improvements for traffic calming on Central Avenue at 8th Street; 980x232x232352, "Harrison & Ruehlman Traffic Calming - Grant," for the purpose of providing ODOT grant resources for right of way improvements for traffic calming on Harrison Avenue at Ruehlman Place; and 980x232x232353, "Harrison & Ruehlman Traffic Calming - TIF," for the purpose of providing tax increment financing resources for right of way improvements for traffic calming on Harrison Avenue at Ruehlman Place; AUTHORIZING the City Manager to accept a Highway Safety Improvement Program Systemic Safety grant (ALN 20.205) in an amount of up to \$600,000 from ODOT, and appropriate an amount up to \$300,000 to newly established capital improvement program project account no. 980x232x232351, "Central & 8th Traffic Calming - Grant," for the purpose of implementing right of way improvements for traffic calming on Central Avenue at 8th Street, and appropriate an amount up to \$300,000 to newly established capital improvement program project account no. 980x232x232352, "Harrison & Ruehlman Traffic Calming - Grant," for the purpose of implementing right of way improvements for traffic calming on Harrison Avenue at Ruehlman Place; AUTHORIZING the transfer and appropriation of the sum of \$90,000 from the unappropriated surplus of Westwood 1 Equivalent Fund 496 to newly established capital improvement program project account no. 980x232x232353, "Harrison & Ruehlman Traffic Calming - TIF; and DECLARING expenditures from capital improvement program project account no. 980x232x232353, "Harrison &

Ruehlman Traffic Calming - TIF," to be for a public purpose because the project will improve pedestrian safety in the Westwood neighborhood.
