**Title:** ORDINANCE (EMERGENCY) submitted by Paula Boggs Muething, City Manager, on 6/21/2021,

AUTHORIZING the transfer and return to source Funds 757 and 758 of the sum of \$1,000,000 from various capital improvement program project accounts for the purpose of decreasing certain existing capital improvement program project accounts and providing resources for the FY 2022 Capital Budget, according to Schedule A of the attached Schedule of Transfer; AUTHORIZING the transfer and appropriation of the sum of \$100,000 from the unappropriated surplus of Special Housing Trust Fund 761 to an existing capital improvement program project account for the purpose of providing resources for that capital improvement program project account, according to Schedule B of the attached Schedule of Transfer; AUTHORIZING the transfer and appropriation of the sum of \$1,000,000 from the unappropriated surplus of Funds 757 and 758 to new capital improvement program project accounts for the purpose of providing resources for certain capital improvement program project accounts, according to Schedule C of the attached Schedule of Transfer; and DECLARING the Warsaw Avenue Creative Campus project to be for a public purpose, all for the

purpose of carrying out the FY 2022 Capital Improvement Program.
